## Details

The district is not holding a traditional Cub Family Campout this year, so we're doing our own. Bring the family and come enjoy good friendship and good eats.

The camp will open at noon on Saturday. If you have other commitments (ballgames, etc.), just get there when you can.

There is a restroom and running water on-site. There is also shelter in case of inclement weather.

We will have games and activities for the boys. We will also have a short Scout Service on Sunday morning.

We will cook and eat dinner together as a pack on Saturday evening. Each family will be responsible for their own breakfast on Sunday.

## What to Bring

Tent, Sleeping Gear, Food for breakfast, completed BSA Medical Forms, and Appropriate clothing (it may be cool in the evening and morning). Scouts should wear their Class B Uniform (pack t-shirt) or other Scout appropriate clothing to the campout and Sunday Service.

## How to Register

- 2) Bring completed BSA Medical Forms for each family member, and
- 3) Pay the \$3/person registration fee to cover food costs.

## Directions to Camp Talking Rock

6600 Mt. Pisgah Road - Take I-575 North through Jasper to mile marker 12. Turn left at the Hwy. 136 Exit. Go 500 ft and turn right at the dead end, then immediately bear right onto Old Highway 5. Go approximately 2.3 miles and turn left onto County Line Road. Go 1 mile and turn right. The entrance will be on the left - look for the yellow pack banner.
